

CHURCH-BASED Compassion programs are delivered exclusively in partnership with the local church. Compassion equips, trains and provides resources so churches may realize their vision of changing their communities by serving children and helping them reach their God-given potential.



HOW DOES COMPASSION INTERNATIONAL HELP?

Compassion supports, encourages and equips children — from conception to self-sufficiency — through four core integrated programs:

Child Survival Program — More Than 30,000 Mothers and Young Children Currently Assisted

The goal of this program is that children survive the early years when they are most vulnerable to disease and malnutrition. Before and after a child is born, mothers are provided the resources and training they need to promote their child's healthy start in life:

- > prenatal care and access to a trained birthing attendant
- > medical care and immunizations
- > group and in-home training in child care
- > emotional and spiritual support
- > nutritional support and access to safe water

Child Sponsorship Program — More Than 1.8 Million Children Currently Assisted

The hallmark of Compassion's work is one-to-one child sponsorship. Through sponsorship support, children are able to participate in a holistic church-based child development program that offers lifechanging benefits:

- > educational opportunities
- > health and hygiene training
- > medical checkups
- > nutritional support
- > stable and caring relationships with student center staff
- > the message of God's love through Jesus Christ




Complementary Interventions

Many crucial activities and initiatives affect and improve the lives of sponsored children and beneficiaries that cannot be met by child sponsorship alone. Through the Complementary Interventions program, Compassion can tackle these unforeseen barriers to a child's development. These interventions include:

- > emergency medical treatment -> crisis response
- > education assistance

- > income-generation training




Accountability is ensured through:
